## Answers

1. 15
2.  $6 \times 1 = 6 \approx 8.82$
3.  $7 \times 4 = 28$  AND suitable reason  
her answer should be about 10 times smaller  
OR her answer is about 10 times too big  
OR  $303.4 \approx 300$  not 28 or 30  
OR the answer could be 30.34 but not 303.4
