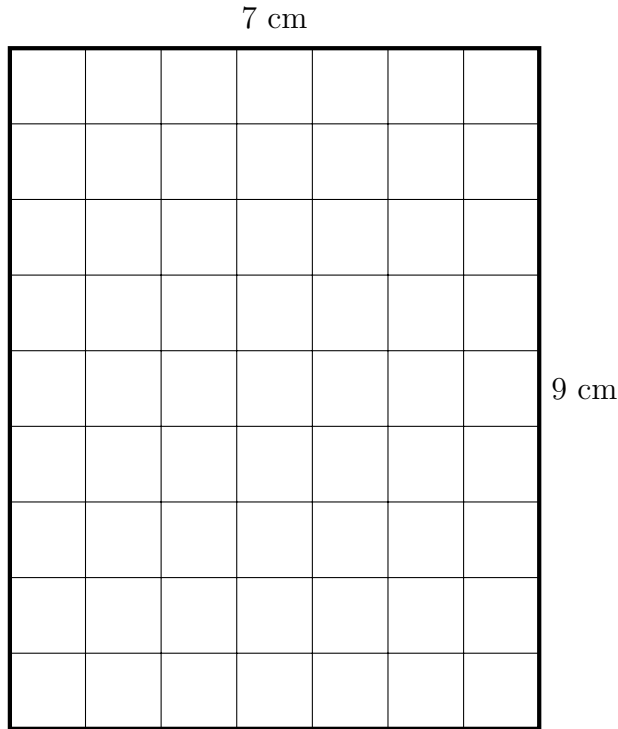


1. Work out the area of these rectangles.
