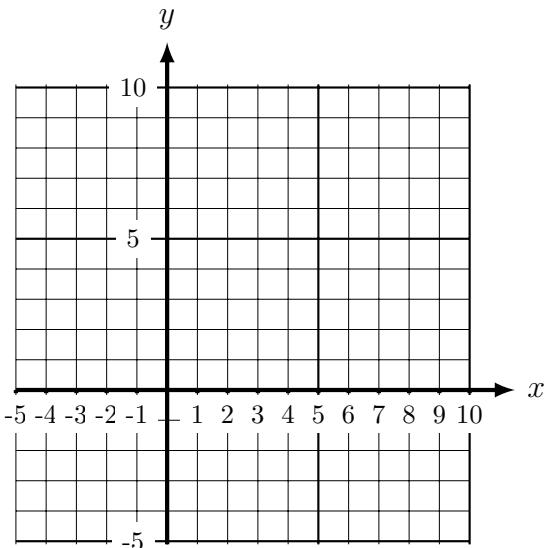


1. (a) Complete the table of values for drawing the line  $y = 2$

(b) On the grid, draw the line  $y = 2$ , for values of  $x$  from 0 to 10.

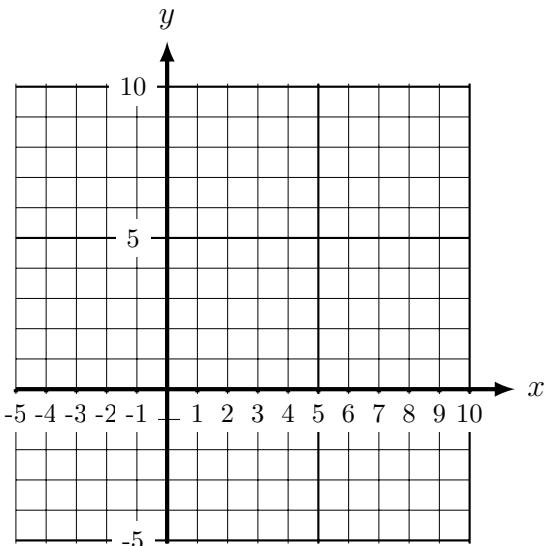




Key of hints:
