

Some people like to use the “9’s trick” on their fingers and thumbs to multiply by 9.

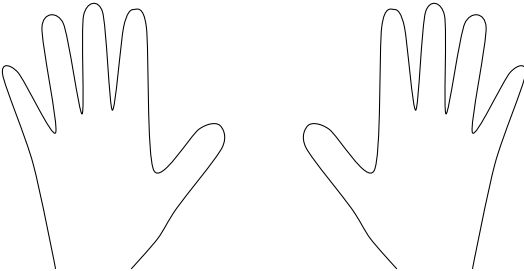

